

## **CAMP CYPRESS - Your Base for an Outback Experience!**



Located in Baradine, north-western NSW, **CAMP CYPRESS** offers you a great opportunity to visit a wide range of attractions!

**SCENIC ATTRACTIONS.** Nearby is the vast **Pilliga Forest** - a haven for an amazing variety of fauna, birdlife and wildflowers. Explore the many bird routes around Baradine and the Pilliga, see koalas at The Aloes, and visit amazing caves such as the Pilliga **Sandstone and Salt Caves**. Historical sites include old saw milling communities such as Wooleybah and Gwabegar.

A visit to the outstanding new **Sculptures in the Dandry Gorge** is a must (the site will be open to the general public in May 2010). The construction of these sculptures was recently featured in the ABC's Artscape program. Another major scenic attraction is the **Warrumbungle National Park** - formed millions of years ago by violent volcanic action. Local Aboriginal cultural and heritage tours and individual bird tours can be arranged.

The award-winning new **Pilliga Forest Discovery Centre** at the National Parks and Wildlife office and the local Land Council **Keeping Place** are both located in Baradine.

**ACCOMMODATION.** Camp Cypress accommodation consists of four comfortable cabins, each with four reverse cycle air-conditioned rooms, each complex with ensuite, and a maximum of six bunks per room. Each cabin has a common room with bar fridge, TV, stainless steel sink, crockery, jug and toaster for continental-style breakfasts.

**CAMPING FACILITIES.** There are 20 powered caravan/camping sites; unlimited space for general camping; male and female shower blocks - each with 8 toilets and 7 shower cubicles; and two backpacker-style bunkhouses, housing up to 20 bunks per bunkhouse.

**CATERING AND TRAINING FACILITIES.** Camp Cypress has a full commercial kitchen and reverse cycle air-conditioned dining room capable of catering for 150 guests. Training facilities include an air-conditioned classroom, OHP and whiteboard.

**BARADINE TOWN FACILITIES** include:

- Supermarket, cafe, coffee shop, newsagency, pharmacy
- Modern hospital, doctor's surgery
- Town sports oval, swimming pool, golf, squash and tennis courts
- Hotels and licensed club
